


How to Change Rate Plan Features on the General Tab

- 1. Select the Rate Plan
- 2. Select the **Edit** button (Pen & Paper symbol)
- 3. In the General tab, make changes to any of the fields as needed
 - Note, the Lock off checkbox and Period field cannot be changed
- 4. Select the **Update** button




How to Change Client Types Attached to a Rate Plan
